## **Plant and Tree Vocabulary**

## **Teacher's Notes**



Level: Intermediate

**Description:** One doesn't have to be green-fingered to admit that some basic Plant and Tree Vocabulary can be pretty handy to know. However, with so many parts and types, these words are not always easy to remember. The exercises in this activity sheet help to familiarise students with useful Plant and Tree Vocabulary, offering them varied practice, both alone and with a partner.

**Aim:** To practise Plant and Tree Vocabulary through a series of written and communicative exercises.

**Procedure:** Give each student a copy of the two-page worksheet.

**Exercise A:** Students begin by matching the beginnings of the sentences with the correct endings.

**Exercise B:** Next, students match the words in bold from Exercise A with their correct definitons.
